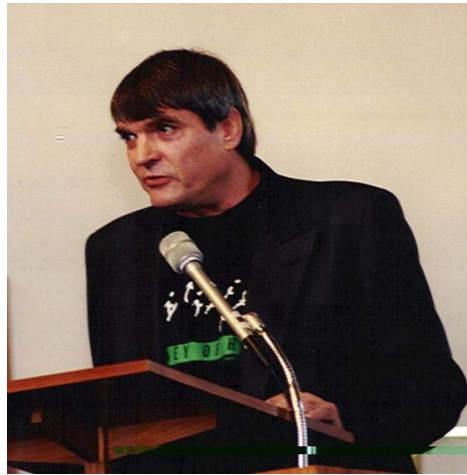

Bill Pelke is the president and cofounder of the Journey of Hope...from Violence to Healing and has authored a book with the same name. He is a board member of the National Coalition and served as chair from 2004-08. Bill is also a founding and present board member of Murder Victims Families for Human Rights, an incorporating board member of Murder Victim's Families for Reconciliation, and serves on the boards of Alaskans Against the Death Penalty and the Journey of Hope. He is a cofounder of the Abolition Action Committee and the annual fast and vigil at the US Supreme court.
